The System by Susan Downs Parrish, Ph.D.

The Superior Unified School District hired me before I completed my dissertation. The dissertation was the final hurdle between me and a Ph.D. Superior, thirty-two miles east of Apache Junction, has been the site of several movies. The surroundings have a ruggedly independent look.

I was horrified when the Superintendent of the District introduced me to people as Dr. Parrish. Hammered into the mindset of a humble student, my impulse was to run from the room before the Head of the Ed Psych Department appeared like a meta-human in *The Flash* to demand an explanation for my decision to impersonate a successful graduate. I exaggerate a little but not much. Despite framing the official document pairing my name with the degree, it took a while to become comfortable with my title.

By the end of my first year on the job, I no longer cringed when addressed as Dr. Parrish, but a new wrinkle appeared—one not easily dismissed. My education proved inadequate. I hadn't been a bad student. I mastered the material in the curriculum, but the gap between what I was taught and what was needed couldn't be ignored. People turned to me for answers that were beyond my bag of tricks.

In the midst of giving up on psychology, I stumbled onto Ralph M. Reitan, Ph.D., a man who knew that a misdiagnosis was not harmless.

Ralph (his students called him Ralph) was a neuropsychologist who understood what it takes to develop the art of arriving at a diagnosis, and yes, coming up with a diagnosis in any branch of psychology is an art. The difference between Ralph and too many other psychologists is that his art was based on science rather than conjecture or supposition or untested hypotheses.

Ralph introduced me to the power of a system based on science. If you know me, you know where I'm going with this. Classical dressage is an art based on a system that rests on science. The system is the Training Scale.

In 2017, the Tucson Dressage Club hosted a number of events. I will mention two of them.

How Conformation Impacts Your Performance and Your Wallet—Choosing the Right Horse for the Job,

Dorie Vlaten-Schmitz presented this Dressage University class held August 19. Dorie's mentor is Gerd Zuther, Reitlehrer. A Reitlehrer is someone the German Equestrian Federation (FN) judges capable of teaching the FEI levels of dressage. The only thing I know of the program Gerd completed is that he remembered being awakened at night and asked to name the six stages in the Training Scale. I can still see the smile on his face as he relived the encounter. My guess is that the program he completed would make my experience of graduate school look like kindergarten. Gerd's roommate was Herbert Rehbein. According to Gerd, Rehbein was gifted in the saddle but struggled with the academic side of the program.

My words can't do Dorie's presentation justice because she included many spectacular slides illustrating her points. She is going to return for another session around the first of next year.

Dorie is an S-level judge. Judging has helped her understand conformation in relation to function. When selecting a dressage horse, start with a "noble" look, one that has an uphill rather than downhill elbow to stifle line. Avoid horses with short front legs. When looking at the shoulder, lay a whip along the shoulder line. This line is as far as the horse can reach with a front leg. Elbow clearance should be one fist's width between the elbow and the body. Ideally, the under-neck muscle is one third the distance of the topline. A pretty head is nice but more important is the space between the jaw bone and C2 of the spinal column, the axis. Two good-sized fingers should fit in this space. The hock should resemble a tulip—a "blooming hock."

If you're planning on growing your prospect, remember that the dam is 60% of what you get. Some genetic correlations between type and performance that you might want to keep in mind are: .35 is average for dressage horses and -.18 is average for jumpers. A correlation of .35 is weak. These weak correlations point to why breeders set high prices on promising prospects for dressage or jumping.

Through the Levels with Debbie McDonald, Symposium/Clinic

On October 14 and 15 at the Pima County Fairgrounds, Debbie McDonald, former Olympic rider, worked with riders of all levels. Debbie's mentor is Klaus Balkenhol. He was awarded the title of Reitmeister in 2011 and was a member of two German Olympic gold medal teams: one in 1992, and the second in 1996. He coached the US Olympic Team when they won a bronze medal at the 2004 Athens Olympics. He is credited with saying: "The horse must perform from joy, not subservience. Praising a horse frequently with voice, a gentle pat, or relaxing the reins is very important to keep the horse interested and willing." Also, "There is a difference between being a leader and being a boss. Both are based on authority. A boss demands blind obedience; a leader earns his authority through understanding and trust."

Debbie reminded riders that dressage is about constant communication, but the art derives from the invisibility of the act. Although she focused on two elements in the Scale: Contact and Straightness, her teaching revealed an awareness of the levels preceding and following these two elements. A down transition should come from the seat more than from the hand. To maintain contact, avoid wiggling the hands left to right. The horse should stretch into the contact so when you give, he stretches onto the bit. Ideally, the horse pushes from behind into the hand. Don't risk the quality of the gait for the movement. If need be, go straight and reestablish the gait, then try the movement again. In trot, consider posting the trot if there is a loss of energy.

Renvers was one remedy she called on when the horse carried his haunches to the inside. Shoulder-in to renvers was a useful pattern for straightening. In tempi changes, a half-halt before the change kept the croup from being high. In the canter pirouette, "one stride in, one stride out, until you can own it." If the horse got stuck, the response was to counter flex and leg yield. As to half-pass, she reminded riders that the movement can't be better than the leg-yield.

Debbie paid attention to detail. Riders were told to "stretch up" and to keep the fingers closed on the reins. She worked with everyone as though they had a future that included moving up the levels to the top. She focused on improving what was offered. In canter-walk transitions she told riders to repeat the movement because it wasn't "sharp enough." Regarding the walk, riders were encouraged to ride as if "always thinking there's a bigger walk in there." She exemplified the idea that "good is the enemy of better." Frequently, riders were reminded of the importance of rewarding the horse with a pat. From what I saw, Debbie reflected Reitmeister Balkenhol's training philosophy. He would be happy to claim her as a student based on her instruction at the symposium.

Considering the mentors of these two women, we know they have been exposed to a deep understanding of the Training Scale. The Training Scale is complex and so much more than the pyramid-shaped representation we know by heart. Those who had a chance to attend these events are likely to have a better grasp of some implications of this system so important to dressage.

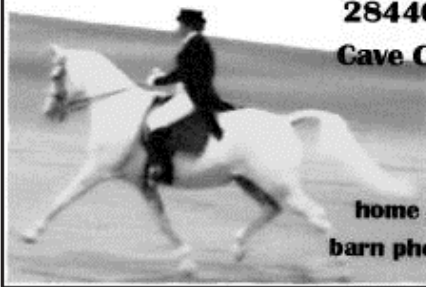

ADA: Where were you born and raised?

The Dressage Foundation's International Dream Program for Young Riders is ready to go for the fourteenth year! The concept of the program evolved as a result of former Olympian Michael Poulin's wish to offer an opportunity for gifted Young Riders to enhance their understanding of dressage theory through a European tour. 


