

US Equestrian Announces New Safe Sport Training Requirements



Lexington, Ky. – On August 27, 2018, the US Equestrian Board of Directors approved a rule change requiring that effective January 1, 2019, all US Equestrian (USEF) adult members with a Competing

Membership must complete USEF's Safe Sport Training in order to be eligible to participate in USEF activities. Members can immediately access the free Safe Sport Training directly through their member dashboard or can click here to learn more. We encourage members to complete the training as soon as possible.

US Equestrian President Murray Kessler stated, "I am very proud of the work done in drafting this proposal and the Board of Directors which approved this critical rule designed to keep our children safe while they enjoy, excel, and advance in our sport."

The rule has three main requirements. Sections 1 and 2 are already in effect and Section 3 has been added:

- 1. Every USEF member and Federation Participant* shall abide by USEF's Safe Sport Policy and the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code of Conduct. *As described by the USEF Safe Sport Policy, a Federation Participant is any USEF member or non-member, who participates in, or attends a USEF-licensed competition or sanctioned event.
- 2. In order to comply with S. 534, the Protecting Young Victim's from Sexual Abuse and Safe Sport Authorization Act of 2017, the USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Center's SafeSport Code of Conduct, every USEF adult member and USEF participant, with the exception of the victim, is required to report suspected sexual misconduct within 24 hours to the appropriate authorities and to the U.S. Center for SafeSport.
- 3. Beginning January 1, 2019, every USEF adult member with a Competing Membership must complete USEF's Safe Sport Training, as approved by the U.S. Center for SafeSport (the Center).

A 30 day grace period to complete the awareness training will be provided to all members who renew or join on or after December 1, 2018. Members joining prior to December 1, 2018 will have until January 1, 2019 to complete the training. Those who do not complete the training within the grace period will be ineligible to participate in USEF activities, including competitions.

The Safe Sport Policy and the rules that govern it have been created to protect all athletes from misconduct within the sport. This new rule is consistent with our efforts to ensure the safety and welfare of equestrian participants, especially minors. Education and training everyone is crucial to protecting athletes and eradicating abuse in our sport.

USEF 'r' Judges Training Program: Part 1

Thanks to The Dressage Foundation and the Shannon Foundation Fund for Judges' Licensing, I was able to attend Part 1 of the USEF 'r' Dressage Judge Training Program August 17-19, 2018, in Saugerties, New York. The program was hosted by NEDA, coordinated by the amazing Sally Davenport and supported by her extraordinary volunteers. The instructor for the program was FEI 4* dressage judge Sarah Geikie.

The flight in from Phoenix to Albany was challenging. The original route was though Chicago, which was experiencing bad weather. The flight was delayed and then changed. I was happy to make it to Albany and arrived three hours later than expected. Fellow candidate Missy Gilliland coordinated the Airbnb and rental car so we were all set.

On Friday, Sarah Geikie worked with the nine candidates to thoroughly study the candidate's notebook, reviewing USEF rules, the basics of dressage methodology and the scale of training. In addition, we watched videos analyzing various qualities of walk, trot and canter and then specific dressage test movements. All of us attended the group dinner at a restaurant by the Hudson Friday night.

Saturday was quite adventurous. All the candidates had an experienced, wonderful scribe to assist us. We made it through the training level oral and actual test judging. Then the rain started by the time we were ready

to begin second level. After judging two tests, the downpour was so intense that we ran for cover. The show had to be cancelled the rest of the day due to severe weather and flooding so our group went back to the host hotel, where we finished judging second level rides from videos. Then Sarah spent time reviewing the tests as we judged them compared to how she judged them. We had discussions about the tests and overall placements. Our group bonded over the experience. Many of us went out for dinner and dessert afterwards. With the excessive rain and lightning, I admit that night I was singing "raindrops on roses" from "The Sound of Music!"



Sunday was back to normal. Thanks to the great footing at HITS-on-the-Hudson, the show was back up and

running at 8:00 a.m. Our group completed first level oral and actual test judging and then reviewed our tests with Sarah's tests and reviewed our overall placings. After lunch we met as a group and then individually with Sarah to see how we were doing and what we needed to improve upon.

Some specific things we learned over the training were:

- 1) Look at the big picture; don't just judge the mistakes. Look at the whole horse—the attitude and confidence. A judge must be able to see the overall picture.
- 2) Have a clear expectation for the gaits.

- 5) Make sure the first-place horse is the one with the best quality and the best training.
- 6) Don't say "needs," say "work for improved ______" or "develop more _____."

Sarah believes it's important to be very specific in the comments and let the rider know what they can do to improve the movements and the overall test. It was an intensive and adventurous weekend. I believe the dressage community has nine wonderful candidates to be the next generation of dressage judges and further the sport.



Multiple riders may qualify on the same horse if the nomination fee has been paid for that horse. If multiple riders qualify on the same horse, **one rider only** may compete in the State Championship classes and the concurrent Fall Festival show. See State Championship Rule 5.





THE PURPOSE OF THE TEST

TRAINING LEVEL - To confirm that the horse demonstrates correct basics, is supple and moves freely forward in a clear rhythm with a steady tempo, accepting contact with the bit.

FIRST LEVEL - To confirm that the horse demonstrates correct basics, and in addition to the requirements of Training Level, has developed the thrust to achieve improved balance and throughness and maintains a more consistent contact with the bit.

SECOND LEVEL - To confirm that the horse demonstrates correct basics, and having achieved the thrust required in First Level, now accepts more weight on the hindquarters (collection); moves with an uphill tendency, especially in the medium gaits; and is reliably on the bit. A greater degree of straightness, bending, suppleness, throughness, balance and self-carriage is required than at First Level.


THIRD LEVEL - To confirm that the horse demonstrates correct basics, and having begun to develop an uphill balance at Second Level, now demonstrates increased engagement, especially in the extended gaits. Transitions between collected, medium and extended gaits should be well defined and performed with engagement. The horse should be reliably on the bit and show a greater degree of straightness, bending, suppleness, throughness, balance and self carriage than at Second Level.

FOURTH LEVEL - To confirm that the horse demonstrates correct basics, and has developed sufficient suppleness, impulsion and throughness to perform the Fourth Level tests which have a medium degree of difficulty. The horse remains reliably on the bit, showing a clear uphill balance and lightness as a result of improved engagement and collection. The movements are performed with greater straightness, energy and cadence than at Third Level.
