So, for whatever the Board's recommendation may be, fall 2019 or spring 2020, she believes that 7 years later an increase is important. She also pointed out that USDF added a requirement for continuing education in order to maintain the L Graduate credentials. She will present the board with an official proposal later (and abstain from voting) but suggests for a 5+ hour judge day: L Graduate \$175, L Graduate with distinction \$200. USEF license \$215 with permission not to exceed \$350 without board approval if we hire R or S judge, for example, in the members only schooling day.

ADA would ask for a reduced fee if less than 5 hours. This may mean we need to slightly increase the non-member, class or office fee on the schooling show sign up form.

The idea was brought forward to expand the Fall Fiesta Show with an ADA members only schooling show on Friday. No motions at this time.

16. Education Committee Report – Sarah Lindsten. No report.

Cynthia Ganem motioned to award and accept the scholarship to Kara Finnegan – AA

Michell Combs – AA, Cyndi Jackson – Open. Kathy Smith second the motion. Board accepted the motion. Ann Damiano will send out the communication to the recipients.

17. Fundraising Committee – Kay Lorenzen. No report. Thanks to Kay's efforts the Spring Celebration Show had a successful outcome in regards to fundraising as every class in the show was sponsored. The board appreciates the support of our membership!

19. Discuss educational programs for 2019/2020 and start publishing them to the membership.

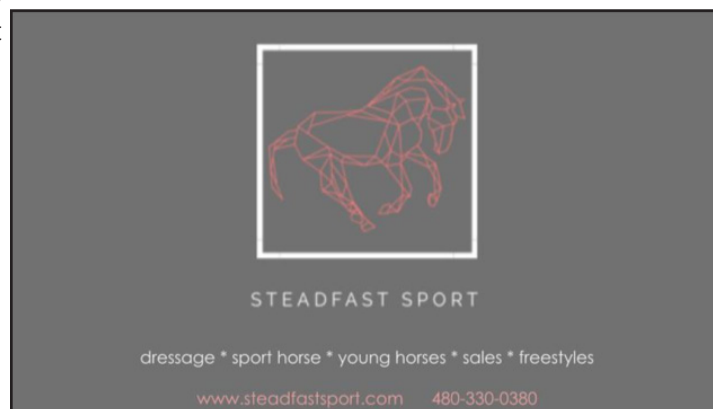
20. Review all Board Members duties/assignment and clarify our Board Roster.

- Arthur Kottas on the Half Pass -

- Never let the horse put more weight on one shoulder than on the other.
- Any adjustment made during half-pass must be done with the inside leg and the outside rein.
- Make sure you are seated well in the axis of the horse with a little more weight on the inside seat bone.
- Make sure the horse is bent from head to tail, but do not ask for too much bend.
- Act in an intermittent manner with your inside leg - don't clamp it on.
- Have the same contact on both reins, never abandon the outside rein. Putting more contact on the inside rein than the outside rein will restrain the movement.
