Reminder to 2019 **AZ State Championship Class Riders**

If multiple riders qualify on the same horse, one rider only may complete in the AZ State Championship classes and the concurrent Open Show which hosts the Championship classes. Arizona State Championship Rule #5

"At no time during the Championship or the concurrent Open Show may any horse entered in the Championship competition be ridden by anyone other than the rider entered in the Championship competition on that horse (Exception: grooms riding on loose rein). Further, any horse entered in the Championship competition, even if entered at two levels, must be ridden by the same rider throughout all days of the competition, including the Open Show held in conjuction with the Championship show."

A Horse-Rider combination may enter the AZ State Championship classes only at the level(s) at which the pair qualified.

The following horses qualified for the 2019 AZ State Champion classes at least twice and had been ridden by more than one person.


- USDF National and Regional GMO volunteer nominations, as well as GMO award nominations, are due to the USDF office by August 31.


